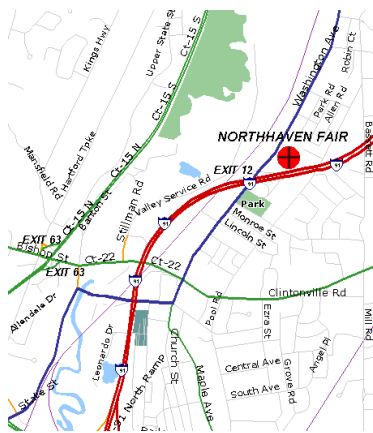

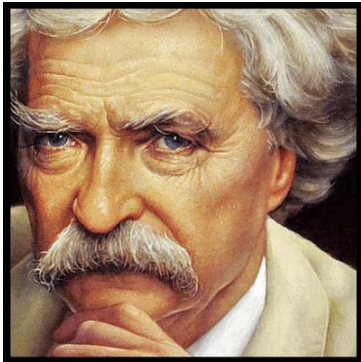

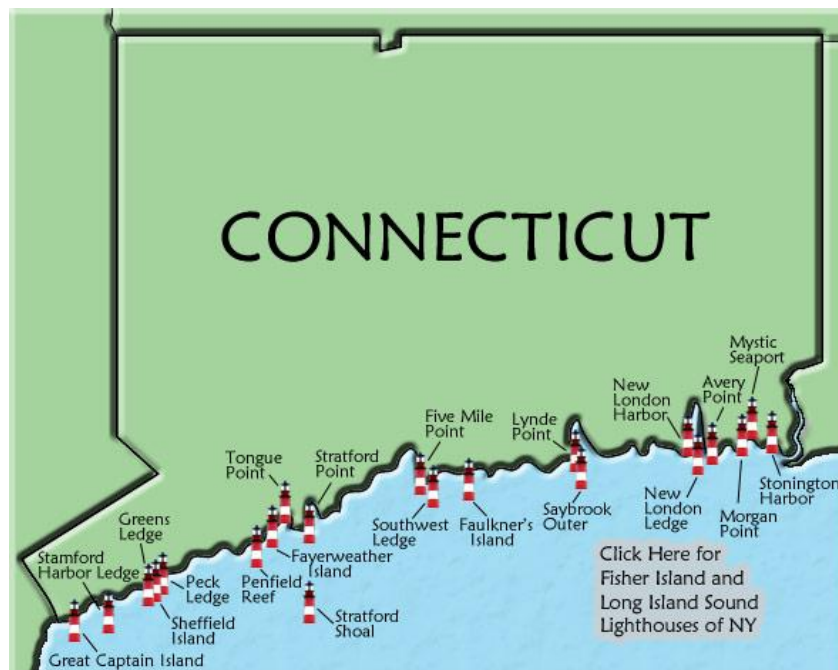

SHOW RULES:

- This show will be governed by the latest rules of the ARBA, and filing of entries indicates acceptance of same.
- Judging shall start promptly at 8:30AM Saturday, May 5th, 2012. ALL ENTRIES MUST BE IN PLACE AND CHECKED IN WITH THE SHOW SECRETARY BY 8.00 A.M. ON SATURDAY
- Entries should be clearly marked as OPEN or YOUTH. All entries not clearly marked will be placed in OPEN. All animals will be judged as entered on the entry form. Substitutions are allowed only in the same VARIETY, CLASS, AND SEX. All substitutions must be made through the show secretary by 8.00 A.M. Saturday.
- Exhibitors are responsible for getting their entries to and from the table promptly. Classes will be called three (3) times after which the judge will continue WITHOUT the missing animals.
- The NEHRF reserves the right to substitute judges in the event of inability of the first selection to officiate. Additional judges may be hired, or Open and Youth judging assignments may be altered to accommodate the number of entries received.
- Judges' decisions are final. Entries may be withdrawn from competition by the show committee and/or judges at their discretion (entry fee forfeited) for interference with the judging process. Indication of ownership of an exhibit is considered interference.
- Any animals showing symptoms of disease of any kind will be immediately removed from building. Stock showing signs of sickness or disease will be removed from the showroom at the discretion of the Show Superintendent and the Show Committee. Exhibitors shall forfeit all premiums or specials on any such animal.
- Cooping is available upon request. Animals not in cooping must have carriers with leak proof bottoms.
- All animals must be permanently and legibly marked in the left ear, or the animal may be eliminated at the judge's discretion. The marking must correspond with the exhibitor's entry form.
- Parents must be responsible for the actions of their children. If there is a problem, you may be asked to leave the fairgrounds. Your entry will be scratched and entry fees forfeited. You will be responsible for any damages to equipment or fairgrounds.
- Chairs and grooming tables will only be allowed if space permits. They must be kept out of aisle ways.
- NEHRF, Associated Clubs, judges, or show personnel will not be responsible in case of fire, theft accidents, losses, providential destruction or damage to exhibitor or stock. Animals are entered at the sole risk of the owner. However, every precaution will be taken to prevent same.
- All show rules will be interpreted by the show committee.
- Specials received too late for publication in the catalog will be posted by the showroom office.
- No breeding of rabbits permitted inside the showroom or on show grounds without consent of Show Superintendent.
